We are pleased to release a new version of our e-book Viewer. In addition to an enhanced design, the Viewer now includes many of the features that you have requested.

- **Cross-Browser Compliant**

You can view e-books on the most popular internet browsers for both Microsoft Windows® and Macintosh®, including Firefox®. All Viewer functionality is the same regardless of the browser used and no plug-ins are required to view content. Find a list of compatible configurations at <http://lib.myilibrary.com/Help.aspx>.

- **Smoother, Less 'Clicky' Page Navigation**

We've made navigating our e-books easier and less 'clicky'. To navigate through the majority of our content, including all new titles, you can use your mouse scroll wheel. The left and right arrows on the keyboard can also be used to navigate the pages of our entire e-book inventory. Finally, we have added buttons which mimic the page navigation buttons found on e-book readers. These new features make navigating our e-book content easier than ever!

- **Copy/Paste Captures Important Information**

When you find pertinent information within an e-book, you can now save it for future reference. Simply highlight the text you want to capture and save it as a Note. To copy and paste the text, use your keyboard shortcuts (Ctrl + C to copy and Ctrl + V to paste). In order to save Notes, you must have a personal account. - **Easier Access to Reference Tools**

We have added our Reference Tools to the Viewer so you can quickly research queries without leaving the e-book page. These tools are also available in the current Web site.

- **Customizable Design Options, including a Setting for Screen-Reading Software**

You can customize your Viewer display by setting preferences under 'My Account'. In addition to customizing the Viewer experience, you can also elect to display the e-book pages in text, for those that require screen-reading software.
